#### Innovation Room

At the Innovation Room 20 Dutch leading cyber security innovations are demonstrated. It also is the place to meet experts from the cyber domain. The Innovation Room is open for cyber professionals, students, and people interested in the latest developments in the cyber security field. It will be opened by the Dutch Minister of Economic Affairs and the Mayor of The Hague.

### Friday 17 April: Access to Capital

Capital is necessary to develop innovative ideas into working systems/products. Therefore, on the final day of the CSW a Dragons Den, and a start-up accelerator programme will take place.
