

The Netherlands Shows Its Innovation Force At The Cyber Security Week (13-17 April)

Together with its partners, The Hague Security Delta (HSD) organises a 'Cyber Security Week' from 13 to 17 April at the HSD Campus, the national innovation centre for security in The Hague. It will be the place to experience how businesses, governments, and knowledge institutions work together in the Netherlands on innovations and knowledge creation in the field of cyber security. The ways the Netherlands invests in cyber security talent (access to talent) and the financing side of innovative ideas and start-ups (access to capital) will also be shown.

Programme

The multifaceted programme includes a Dragons Den, Hague Talks, a hack lab for primary school students, an international matchmaking programme, workshops, and debates. The highlight will be a two-day Innovation Room where demonstrations of Dutch innovations in the field of cyber security will be shown. The Innovation Room will be officially opened on Wednesday April 15th by Henk Kamp, Minister of Economic Affairs and Jozias van Aartsen, mayor of the city of The Hague.

The Cyber Security Week will take place in the same week as the NCSC One Conference and the Global Conference on Cyber Space (GCCS2015) - bringing more than 100 international delegations to The Hague - and will be a great opportunity to put the innovation force of the Netherlands on the map globally.
